**RESOLUTION OF ADVISORY NEIGHBORHOOD COMMISSION 4D CONCERNING
FUNDING FOR SHERMAN CIRCLE REPAIRS**

Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4D takes note of the following:

1. **WHEREAS** Sherman Circle Park is managed by the National Park Service, including all capital investments and repairs;
2. **WHEREAS** Sherman Circle Park is heavily used by pedestrians and children, including numerous young children learning to walk, run, bike, and scoot;
3. **WHEREAS** Sherman Circle Park has been plagued in recent years by broken and uneven sidewalks in the interior of the Circle, leading to dangerous tripping hazards and poor drainage during heavy rainfall;
4. **WHEREAS** the Superintendent of Rock Creek Park has indicated to interested residents that NPS would like to fix the sidewalk issues, but that such a project would require dedicated funding in the NPS budget for the repairs;
5. **WHEREAS** the last year has seen the removal of multiple dead trees from Sherman Circle and the surrounding parklets;
6. **WHEREAS** water fountains in Sherman Circle Park have not functioned for years;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4D:

1. **Requests** that the National Park Service include funding in its upcoming FY 2026 budget proposals for the Superintendent of Rock Creek Park to undertake
 - a. Sidewalk repairs in Sherman Circle,
 - b. Any needed repairs to restore functioning water fountains to Sherman Circle, and
 - c. Re-planting of new native trees to replace the trees that have been recently removed;
2. **Further requests** that the Superintendent of Rock Creek Park endeavor to undertake these projects with haste, pending funding;
3. **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That Commissioner Aman George (4D06) is hereby authorized to represent the commission in all matters relating to this resolution.**

This Resolution of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4D Concerning Funding for Sherman Circle Repairs was considered on October 16, 2024 before ANC 4D at a duly noticed meeting of the Commission in the presence of a quorum.

The vote of the Commission was 6 in favor, 0 against, and 0 abstentions. The resolution is hereby adopted as resolution number 4D-2024-07.
